The Massachusetts Outdoor Exposition is the largest event of its kind in New England. Due to its extraordinary growth and popularity, **on-site parking is now strictly reserved for volunteer staff and those requiring handicapped access (plate required)**. To accommodate the public, convenient off-site **FREE** parking areas are provided by our generous friends at the **Securos** facility (443 Main Street) on the south side of Route 20, and at **Burgess Elementary School** (45 Burgess School Road, off Cedar Street on the north side of Route 20). **FREE** shuttle bus transportation runs nonstop to and from these locations throughout the day.

For your convenience and safety, we ask that you please go directly to the **FREE** parking area at Securos (follow signs to Expo Parking). From there, simply take the free bus shuttle that runs to and from the Big MOE throughout the day. See you there!
